So, enjoy this Easter themed newsletter and the coming holidays.



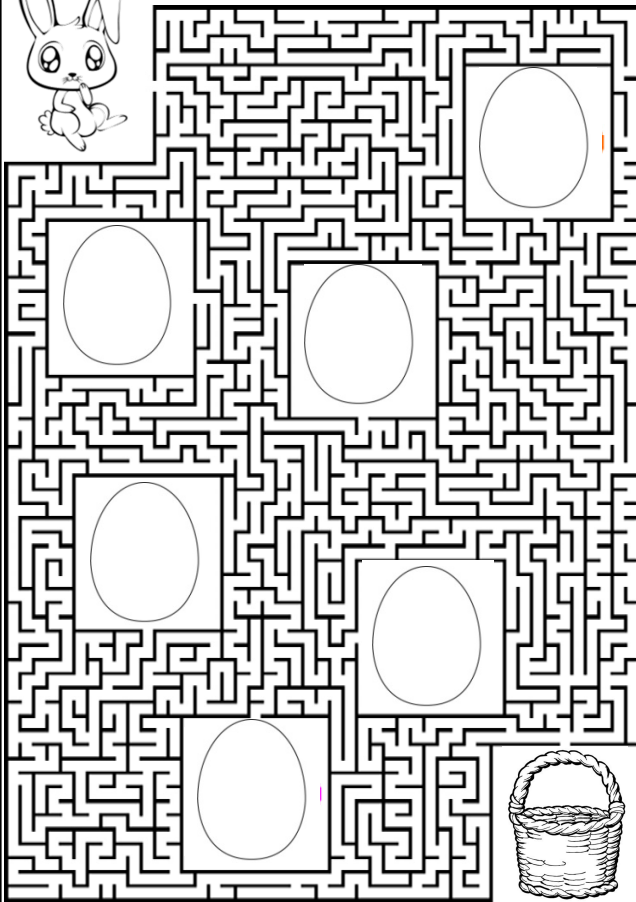
Bunny Maze

4th GREEN / 5th - RED / 6th - PINK

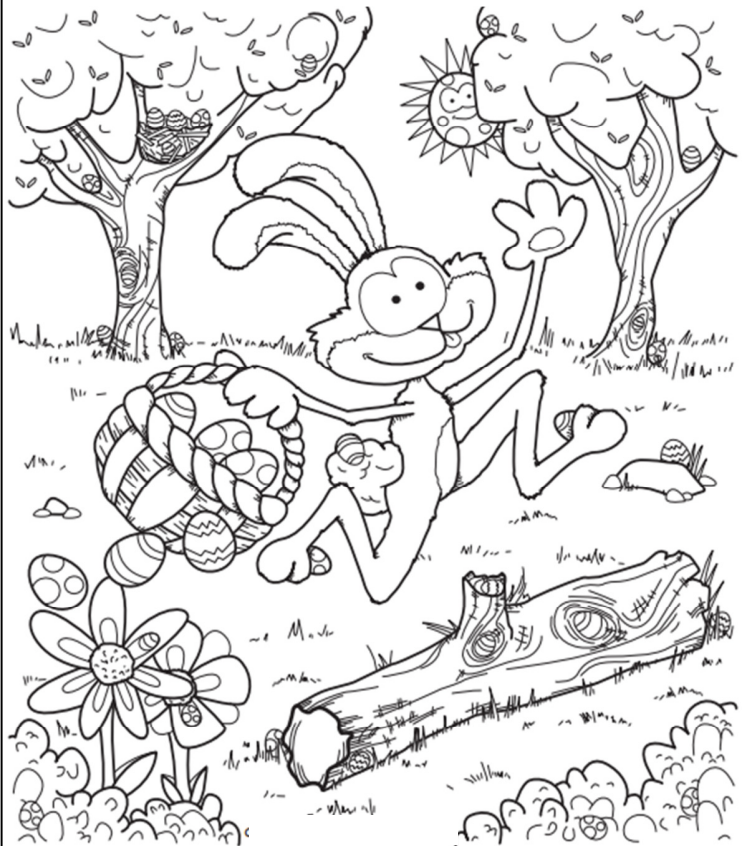


Easter Egg Hunt

Colour all the eggs you can find.



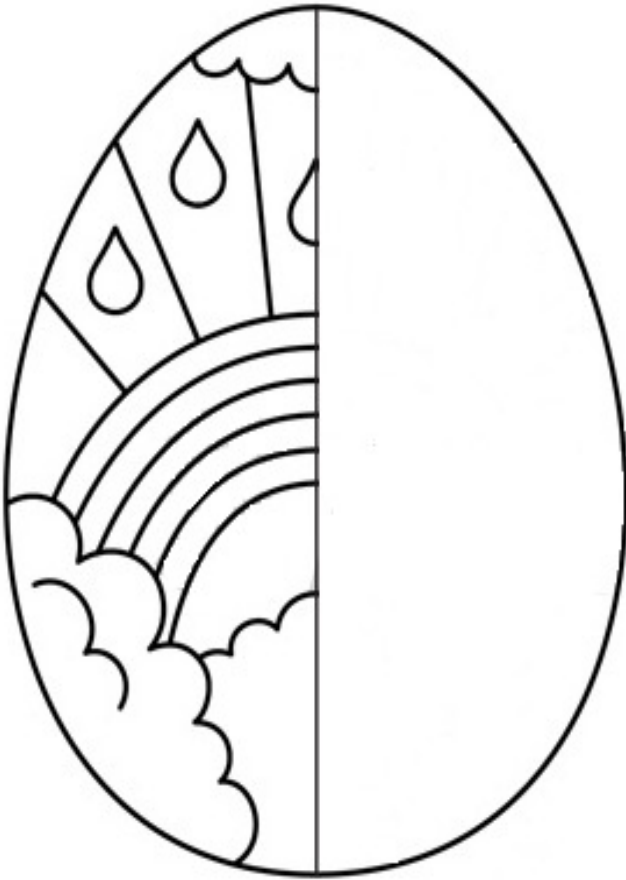
How many Easter eggs did you find?

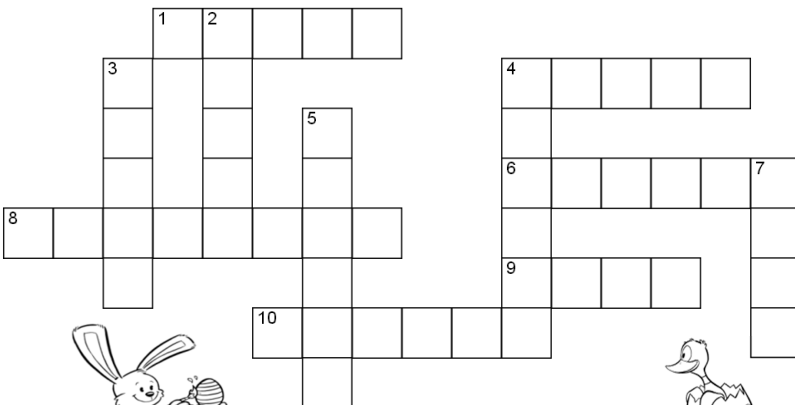
